EU regulation no. 1907/2006 - REACH

REACH - Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals

In accordance with the EU regulation No. 1907/2006 Article 3 No. 34 and No. 35, we, as manufacturers of drives and control units for sun protection and industrial applications, are a typical "industrial purchaser of materials, preparations and products" and thus a "downstream user".

Our suppliers are thus obligated to comply with the EU regulation no. 1907/2006 - REACH and the defined compulsory registration with the European chemical agency ECHA.

EU directive no. 2011/65/EU - RoHS II

RoHS - Restriction of certain Hazardous Substances

The EU directive no. 2011/65/EC - RoHS II forbids the bringing onto the market of products that contain certain substances in concentrations exceeding the respective limit value. These are in particular cadmium (Cd), lead (Pb), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (CR-VI) as well as polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and decabromodiphenyl ethers (DBDE).

We hereby confirm that our products with an EU declaration of conformity and CE-mark meet the requirements of the EU directive no. 2011/65/EU - RoHS II.
